- Managing Co-occurring Medical Conditions Many individuals with ASD have conditions such as epilepsy (30%), gastrointestinal disorders (50%), and sleep disturbances (80%) that require medical monitoring (Tye et al., 2019).

- Supporting Activities of Daily Living (ADLs) Assisting with bathing, dressing, eating, and personal hygiene while considering sensory sensitivities.
- Preventing Hospitalizations Individuals with autism are at a higher risk for emergency room visits due to uncontrolled seizures, infections, or behavioral crises (Vohra et al., 2016). Private Duty Nurses help reduce hospital admissions by providing proactive inhome care.
- Behavioral and Emotional Support Working alongside families and therapists to implement individualized care plans, reinforce positive behaviors, and provide structured routines that improve daily functioning.
- Family Respite & Education Giving caregivers a much-needed break while also

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educating families on techniques to enhance daily care, reduce anxiety, and improve communication.

The Growing Need for Autism Support

- 1 in 36 children in the U.S. is diagnosed with autism (Maenner et al., 2023).
- Up to **40% of autistic individuals are nonverbal**, requiring alternative communication methods and specialized care (Tager-Flusberg & Kasari, 2013).
- Over 85% of autistic adults remain unemployed or underemployed due to lack of support services (Taylor et al., 2015).
- Adults with autism are **three times more likely** to develop chronic health conditions (Croen et al., 2015).
